Application

Kindergarten - 12 th Grade	\$100	All students are required to pay an application fee. This fee is due with the application and is non-refundable even if the student is not accepted at TCA.
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Annual and Semi-Annual tuition options must pay admission fees and tuition by July 1st to qualify for a tuition discount. For recurring credit payment, monthly in office and automatic tuition payment options, fees are due on or before August 1st.

Admission Fees

Kindergarten	\$565	Due by August 1st This fee pays for school owned curriculum and testing supplies, yearbook, insurance and helps offset the cost of transportation. Fee is non-refundable.	
1 st - 12 th Grade	\$665		
Kindergarten - 12 th Grade	\$100	Upgrade	Due Aug 1st (or monthly installments). This fee helps pay for expenses related to maintaining and upgrading buildings and grounds. Fee is non-refundable.
Kindergarten - 12 th Grade	\$20	Technology Fee	Due Aug 1st This fee is used for rendering technology resources and services to enhance the students' learning environment. Fee is non-refundable.

Graduation

12 th Grade	\$110	Graduation	Due by Aug 1st Fee is non-refundable.
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Annual Tuition

Kindergarten - 5 th Grade	\$7140	Multiple Child Discount - A discount is available on tuition for family members based on the following scale: 1 st student - no disc., 2 nd student - 10% off, 3 rd student - 15% off, 4 th and subsequent students - 20% off. Faithful Members of Trinity Church for a 12 month period may qualify for a 10% discount, which will be applied to tuition. Please alert the Business Office if you believe you qualify.

Resource / PACE Program

Kindergarten - 12 th Grade	Resource \$1000	A consultation program entailing monitoring, consulting, training, accommodations and modifications on assignments. All students on the McKay Scholarship, students who request to enter this program or students who are ESOL will incur this fee. Entrance into the program may require administrative approval.
Kindergarten - 12 th Grade	PACE \$500	PACE program consists of learning sessions on a one-to-one basis with teacher and student. Workbooks and materials are provided based on assessment needs. PACE will enhance a student's ability to achieve academic goals when needed.

Dual Enrollment Program

11 th - 12 th Grade	\$600	Dual Enrollment Program allows high school students to take college courses for credits prior to high school graduation.
11 th - 12 th Grade	\$40	Dual Enrollment Biology Lab Fee

CLOTHING

Uniforms

Kindergarten – 12 th Grade		All students are required to wear TCA uniforms purchased through our school store, Eagles Nest Bookstore. See attached Uniform & Apparel Guide
Cadets	\$120	Cadet Uniforms (Excluding Boots)

Physical Education Uniform

7 th - 12 th Grade	\$30	Students taking PE in grades 7 th through 12 th are required to wear a PE uniform.
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ART FEE

K-5 -12 th Grade	\$25	Art supply fees are as follows: K-5-6 th grades \$10 (all students); 7-8 th grades \$15; 9-12 th grades \$25 (if art is chosen as an elective in middle or high school)
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TARDIES

Kindergarten – 12 th Grade	\$5	Three unexcused tardies are allowed each quarter. A \$5 fine will be assessed for all unexcused tardies beyond the three.
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Below are other fees that may be incurred throughout the school year depending on your choice to utilize our available programs. In addition, expenses such as clubs, music lessons, pictures, etc. are all optional.

Athletics

Sport Fees	\$135	\$25 less for each additional sport for the year. Example: for one student playing all three sports - Football \$135, basketball \$110, baseball \$85. Sport fees are implemented to help offset the cost of fields, equipment, officials and transportation. Additional fees may apply. K-5-5 th grade intramurals \$45
Sport Fees (Homeschooled Students)	\$250	\$250 Per Sport

Band Instrument Rental

7 th – 12 th Grade	\$300 Per Year	Instrument rental available if student does not own an instrument.
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Cafeteria

Kindergarten – 12 th Grade	\$990/ Year	Complete hot lunch for 180 school days. A la carte items are available for an additional charge. Per day charge is \$5.50.
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Extended Care

Kindergarten – 12 th Grade		Morning Care 6:30 am – 7:40 am \$20/Wk or \$7/Day Afternoon Care 3:15 pm – 6:00 pm \$45/Wk or \$12/Day
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Field Trips

Kindergarten – 12 th Grade	\$75 Per Trip	\$75 is the cost of a typical field trip. Grades 6 th through 9 th Encounter Camp \$160; Grades 8 th & 9 th Washington DC \$1300; Grade 12 Senior Trip \$600
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Summer School

Kindergarten – 12 th Grade	\$750	Summer school is an extension of the school year for students who may be retained or whose graduation may be in jeopardy.
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Tutoring

Kindergarten – 12 th Grade	\$50/Hour	Based on academic needs, tutoring is available at a cost of \$50 per hour.
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Calculators

7 th – 12 th Grade	\$150	A basic Texas Instrument calculator available through our school store for \$25 is required for all middle and high school math. Graphic calculators which are also sold for \$150 are recommended for pre-calculus and calculus students. Other electronics may be used in the classroom upon approval.
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
